Transportation

Due to the steady decline in ridership, **effective Monday, March 30, ADOT will begin operating on a modified Saturday schedule, with no evening Purple Route bus.** We will continue to operate the State Shuttle service until 8:00 PM. Below is a public advisory notice and a notice that will be posted on our buses and in bus shelters.

ADOT further reduces bus service due to the Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Effective Monday March 30, 2020, the City of Annapolis Transit System will reduce its bus service as follows:

Weekdays (Monday - Friday) ADOT will operate a modified Saturday bus schedule. There will be no evening Purple Route Bus.

Bus service will begin at 7:15AM and conclude at 6:50PM. The State Shuttle will operate until 8:00PM

Public Transportation Services

Annapolis Transit provides public transportation services through regular fixed routes, shuttle and ADA complementary paratransit services. All transit vehicles are wheelchair accessible. Individual portable oxygen tanks are acceptable on all transit vehicles.

The Annapolis Transit service area is approximately 23 square miles including the City of Annapolis and surrounding Anne Arundel County areas.

Parking Enforcement & Management Services

The Parking Enforcement and Management Services include the enforcement of on-street parking, management of city owned parking garages and residential parking programs.

What is the Circulator?

It is a trolley that quickly and efficiently moves individuals from the City's four parking garages around the Central Business District, Westgate Circle to Memorial Circle, allowing the public to enjoy the unique shops, the food and entertainment, the historic charm and maritime attractions. The Circulator makes convenient stops along its route at:

Park Place – 5 Park Place

Knighon Parking Garage – 1A Colonial Avenue

Intersection of West Street & Calvert Street

Gotts Court Parking Garage – 25 Northwest Street

State Garage – 19 St. Johns Street

North Street & State Circle

School Street & State Circle

Church Circle at South Street

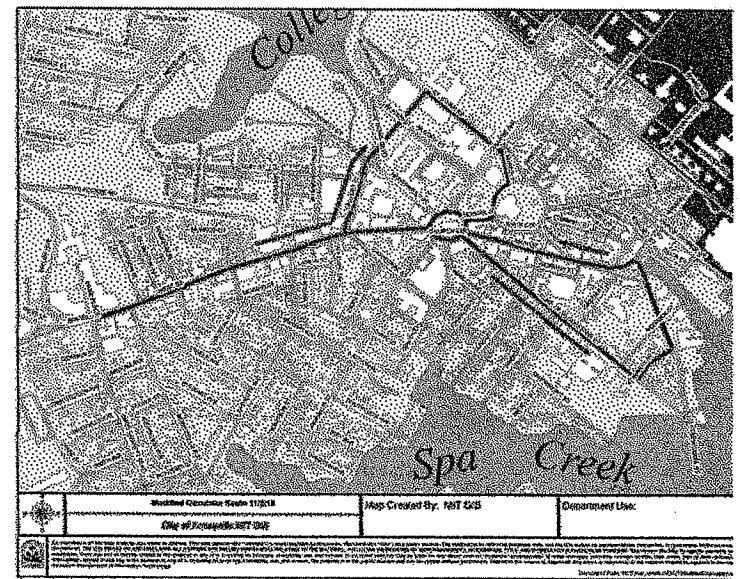


